Stable under normal use and storage conditions. May react with strong acids and oxidizers.

**VIII Fire and Explosion Data**

Cleaning lotion used to impregnate the non-woven fabric is not flammable or explosive (Flashpoint >210 °F). Non-woven fabric supports combustion when ignited. Polyurethane will burn if exposed to sufficient heat source. Once ignited, it may degrade and melt to a combustible liquid.

Products of non-woven combustion: Oxides of carbon, sulfur, and nitrogen; aliphatic and aromatic hydrocarbons.

Products of polyurethane combustion may include carbon monoxide, acetaldehyde, acrylonitrile, toluene diisocyanate, oxides of nitrogen, and hydrogen cyanide.
